

Becoming a Board Member

About the organization: Sacramento Peers on Prevention (SacPOP) is a youth driven organization and our goal is to reach out to youth in the Sacramento area and encourage them to get tested and treated for HIV and other STDs. SacPOP believes that it is important to empower youth and encourage risk reduction behaviors with their peers.

Mission: Empower youth to take action and control of their health.

SacPOP is seeking community-focused leaders to serve on the board in order to push our mission forward. Those interested in being a board member, must be passionate about improving the sexual health and wellbeing of youth and making a difference in the community.

SacPOP is seeking members for the following committees:

- 1. **Fundraising and Grants Committee:** Responsible for researching grants for the purposes of implementing or sustaining program goals; propose and implement fundraising events, campaigns, etc.; and seek external funding support.
- 2. **Finance Committee:** Develop the budget, track and monitor funding.
- 3. **Marketing/Communications Committee:** Develop a marketing plan, create press releases, and track and monitor marketing impact.
- 4. Youth Engagement Committee: Ensure that youth are a part of decision making, including, campaigns, marketing plans, and outreach.

Commitment:

Two-year commitment on at least one board committee. All board members are required to attend board meetings (in-person or teleconference) which will be held quarterly on the first Saturday of the month and at other times as deemed necessary. Meetings will be held in September, December, March and June. The board members must support all events by advertising and attending. All board members will commit to making annual donations to the organization.

Other duties and responsibilities include:

- 1. Provide support to the Chief Executive Officer.
- 2. Assist in fundraising efforts.
- 3. Promote events to colleagues, friends and family.
